Home essentials

Our home is spread over four floors and has lift access which aids accessibility for those with impaired mobility.

Our 51 bedrooms all have en-suite wet rooms that can be adapted with equipment to meet a person's individual needs and each floor has an accessible, fully equipped, assisted bathroom.

The home has an extensive bespoke designed sensory garden to cater for varying levels of physical and cognitive ability. Each level has accessibility with spaces for quiet reflection, garden clubs, activities, and events.

The design of our lounges has made the most of the stunning views, with floor to ceiling windows that allow uninterrupted views of the surrounding countryside. Although the home is large, with a spacious and bright feel, it has been explicitly designed to have a homely feel with quiet spaces. This gives our ladies and gentlemen that like to socialise a place to spend time together, making friends and entertaining, but when quiet reflection is the order of the day, there are lots of places to sit quietly reading, knitting, watching the wildlife or just catching up with a dear friend with a cuppa.
